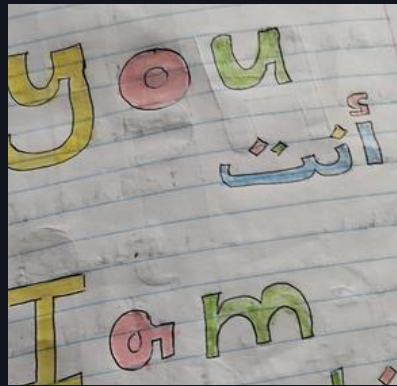
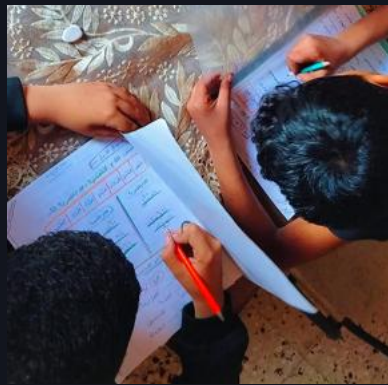

ABOUT US

We are a Palestinian-led grassroots organization, officially established in October 2023 by Palestinians living abroad and their allies, dedicated to supporting the people of Gaza. Our mission is to empower the people of Gaza by helping them bring their ideas to life and fostering a brighter future for their community. The NGO gaz.aid is registered in Switzerland.

OUR MISSION

Gaza and its people face relentless conflict and a constant humanitarian crisis. Yet, they remain resilient, creative, and determined to strengthen their community.

We provide fast, direct, and unbureaucratic support to turn their ideas into action.

- **Rapid Resource Distribution:** We mobilize quickly in times of crisis through grassroots organizing, led by trusted community members.
- **Support Based on Local Needs:** We provide social and material support directly driven by the needs identified by the people in Gaza.
- **Long-Term Sustainable Support:** We are committed to providing long-term, sustainable support to the most vulnerable people impacted by violence and conflict, particularly children.

Our Current Objective: Our primary objective is to raise funds through crowdfunding. Due to the ongoing siege in Gaza, there is a severe shortage of nearly every basic necessity. Our goal is to collect funds so that—as soon as the siege lifts—we can swiftly deploy essential resources like food, clothing, and other necessities to the areas where they are needed most.



OUR VALUES

This is what we are standing for:

- **Universal Rights:** We believe that safeguarding human dignity, equality, and well-being is essential. We stand firmly in the belief that human rights are inalienable and must be upheld for all people, especially in the midst of war and chaos. This includes unfettered access to basic resources necessary for survival—such as food, water, clothing, medicine, and shelter—as well as a secure social and emotional environment that provides safety, community, and opportunities for gainful employment.
- **Empowerment:** We prioritize community-led solutions as they are crucial to any humanitarian disaster response. These solutions foster a sense of ownership and resilience within affected communities and ensure that interventions are tailored to local needs and cultural contexts. By empowering individuals and communities to actively participate in their recovery, we promote self-sufficiency, sustainable solutions, and a more compassionate, effective response.
- **Humanity:** We recognize that the suffering of the people in Gaza is a consequence of a deeply rooted historical conflict. However, we reject the politicization of the humanitarian needs of the people of Gaza. We stand firm in our commitment to the humanity of Palestinians and all those impacted by the violence of war.

02. CONTEXT

SITUATION IN GAZA



Gaza has never known a life of peace or prosperity. Even before the recent war, the approximately 2.23 million people living in this small, densely populated strip endured daily hardship - bombings, destruction, suppression, and loss. For years, Gaza has been described as an open-air prison, a place where freedom and stability are distant dreams.

Following the war declared by Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu on October 7, 2023, the situation escalated to unprecedented levels of devastation. The scale of death, destruction, and suffering is unimaginable.

By the end of 2025, Gaza had witnessed:

- Killed: At least 67,000 people, including 20,000 children
- Injured: More than 169,000 people
- 25% Malnutrition: One child in four suffers from severe acute malnutrition

92% of Gaza's residential buildings have been damaged or destroyed, 88% of commercial facilities, and 92% of school buildings require complete reconstruction. 125 hospitals have also been damaged, while 89% of Gaza's water and sanitation infrastructure has been destroyed or severely impacted.

Additionally, nearly 300 journalists were killed in the line of reporting, while the destruction of homes, schools, hospitals, and essential infrastructure has left Gaza facing an unprecedented humanitarian and reconstruction crisis.

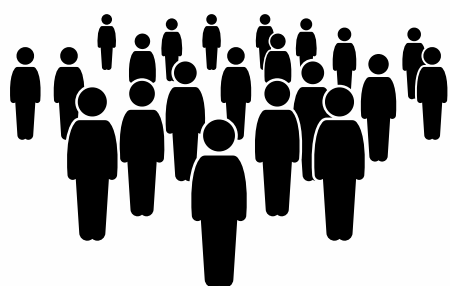




03. PROJECTS

Despite soaring market prices, escalating destruction, repeated displacement, and the worsening humanitarian situation, our team remained committed to providing direct, uncomplicated, and unbureaucratic support. At the same time, blocked and rejected transfers by PostFinance repeatedly delayed essential payments, causing us to miss critical opportunities to support our team and humanitarian actions on the ground.

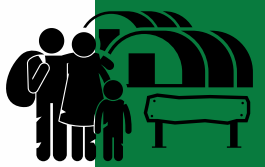

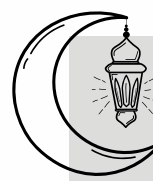

RAMADAN ACTION

Date: March 2025

Location: Gaza City

Costs: 500€

Impact:

Ramadan is a time of peace and reflection - but in Gaza, many families spent it among rubble, loss, and hunger. With homes destroyed and hope fading, our Ramadan Action aimed to bring dignity and relief.

We provided nutritious food parcels to 100 families, helping them celebrate despite unimaginable circumstances. Additionally, 6 families facing extreme hardship received direct financial support to cover urgent needs.

In the heart of destruction, we offered not just aid - but solidarity and remembrance.





KARIM CENTER

Date: May - September 2025

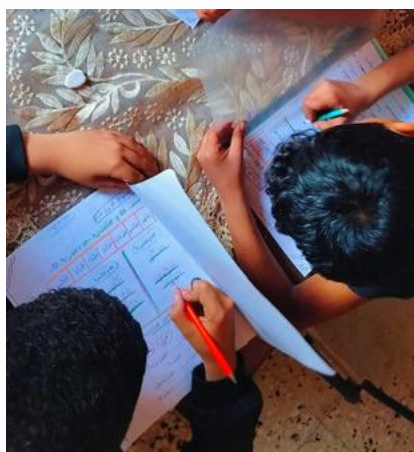

Impact:

In the midst of war and ongoing destruction, Karim Center became a safe space for children who had lost stability, routine, and access to education. Despite damaged infrastructure, displacement, and the constant uncertainty of daily life, the need for learning and emotional support remained stronger than ever.

Through the dedication of our local project manager, Asil, around 30 children were able to attend classes every day, finding not only education but also a sense of normality, connection, and hope. Karim Center became a reminder that even in the darkest circumstances, children's right to education must be protected.





FOOD DISTRIBUTION

Location: Khan Younis

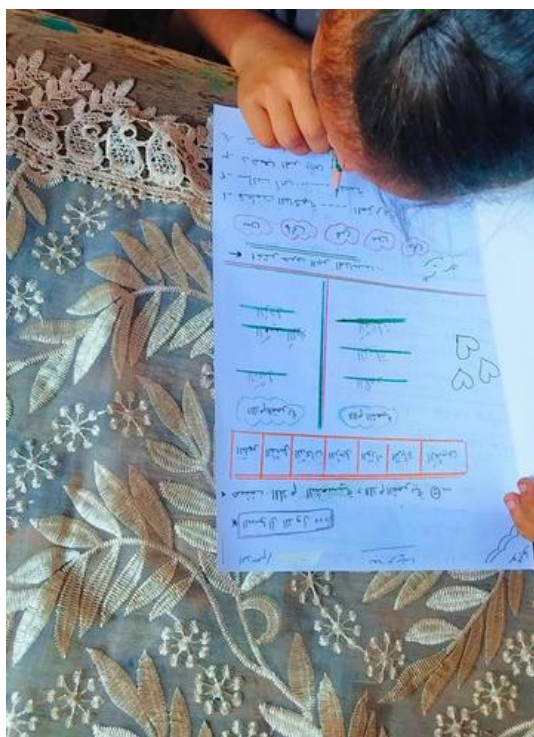

Impact:

After the ceasefire was announced, there was little left to celebrate. The true scale of the destruction only became clear in its aftermath, revealing a humanitarian catastrophe even greater than anticipated. Countless families had lost everything after being displaced repeatedly over the course of two years.

As soon as market prices stabilized enough to make a distribution possible, we provided food parcels to more than 70 families who were struggling to meet even their most basic needs. For parents who no longer knew how they would feed their children, this support offered immediate relief.

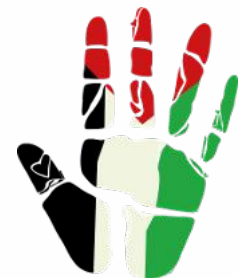


RESTRUCTURED BOARD OF GAZ.AID

Our ultimate goal for 2026 is to reopen Karim Center and continue creating spaces for education, dignity, and hope for children in Gaza.



WORKING TOWARDS LASTING PEACE

While we continue to advocate for a lasting ceasefire and an end to the blockade and illegal occupation, we remain committed to responding to the immediate humanitarian needs of the people in Gaza. As conditions allow, we aim to transition from emergency support towards long-term projects that contribute to sustainable recovery and resilience.

Until then, we will continue to provide fast, direct, and unbureaucratic support wherever it is needed most.
